### **Authority to issue trespass warnings and notices**

This letter seeks your authorisation to trespass persons from private land you own or occupy where it is adjacent to public land.

Police and council regulate activity on public land and are concerned with any activity that adversely affects the use or enjoyment of public land. These activities may include but are not limited to glue sniffing, consuming alcohol, camping, busking contrary to guidelines (duration, volume etc), trading without a permit and begging.

If these activities occur on your land, completing this form will allow council officers and the police to deal with them.
