

Beresford Square Hub demolition

We are now ready to start the final stage of demolition in Beresford Square with the removal of the concrete slab where the old café once stood, along with the former below ground toilets.

The demolition will involve concrete cutting, jackhammering, excavating and removal of material utilising trucks. The trucks will enter and exit the site from Hopetoun Street at the lower end of the square.

We anticipate to start 20 August.

We will be reducing the utilities work in the Square over the next two weeks. We are extremely grateful for your patience and understanding during this complex stage of the project.

As the utilities work reduces we will be constructing the guide wall for Diaphragm Wall and the permanent hoardings will go up. Stay tuned for more details to come about a little celebration to mark this major milestone.

Hours of work

Our normal hours of work are 7am to 10pm, Monday to Friday and 7am to 7pm Saturday.

How will this affect me?

Aspects of this work will create some noise and vibration. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts by using noise mats and equipment that generates less noise. Monitoring systems are in place around the site to ensure we adhere to approved parameters.
