

Kia ora koutou katoa,

We hope that you and your families have stayed safe and well during the COVID-19 Alert Level 4 lockdown period.

We would like to inform you that construction on Link Alliance worksites will recommence from Tuesday, 28 April when New Zealand moves to Alert Level 3.

You may see some of our workers on site this week. They are undertaking preparatory works to ensure that sites will be compliant with Alert Level 3 protocols and we are ready to begin construction work next Tuesday. Further specific information on works restarting in your area and what it will mean for you will be provided over the next day or two.

Our first priority remains keeping our workers and the wider community safe. Link Alliance workers will strictly adhere to Government protocols for working under Alert Level-3, including physical distancing on-site and a cleaning regime.

If you need to move around our construction sites, please continue to follow social distancing rules and follow instructions provided by our team and on construction signage.

We understand that there's currently a lot of uncertainty and hardship due to the impacts of COVID-19, and we will work to minimise impacts of our construction works as much as possible, including expediting works where possible during this phase.

We remain committed to providing timely information to you on works so that you're able to make informed decisions for your futures. We also want to ensure you continue to have the opportunity to communicate, engage and participate in the project. Please don't hesitate at any point to get in touch with us if you have any questions or concerns.

The CRL project is a key element of New Zealand's economic stimulus, and the Link Alliance has spent the Level 4 lockdown period preparing to start construction works as quickly and safely as possible at Alert Level 3. The project is a largescale procurer of goods and services and will provide employment for up to 1600 people at peak.

While New Zealanders continue to practice social distancing to keep everyone safe, there are limitations to how we can communicate with you. For now we will continue prioritising digital platforms.
