

Canada Street traffic control update

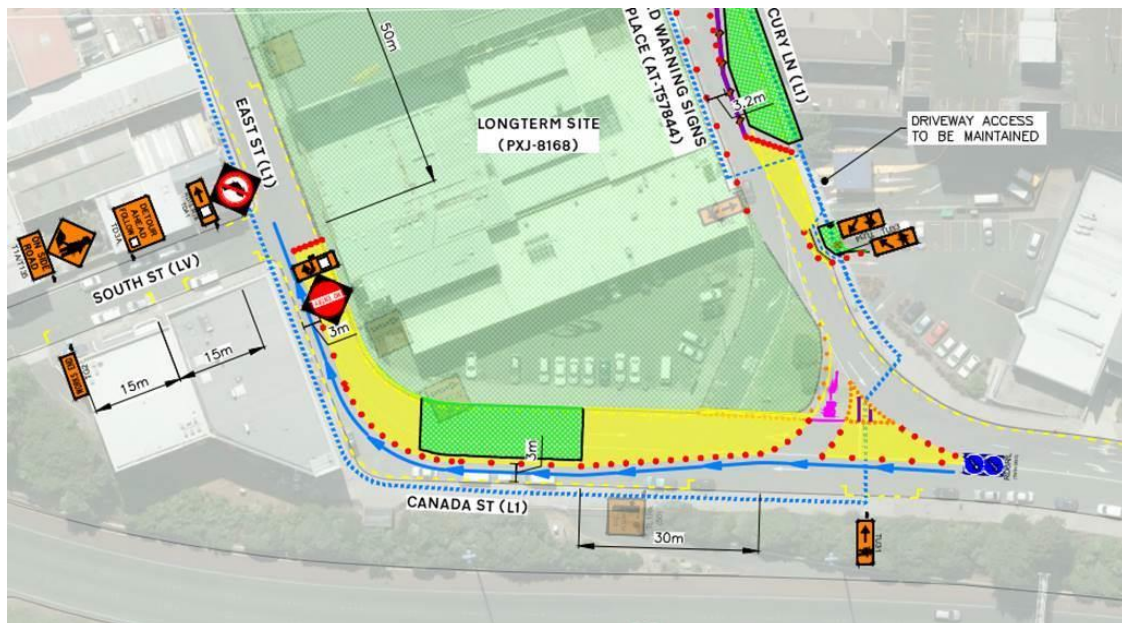
Dear neighbours,

We hope that you and your families are safe and well during this time. As you are probably aware construction activity across our three sites – Aotea, Karangahape and Mt Eden – will continue during alert level 3, with strict guidelines in place.

From **Friday 21 to 23 August** a road diversion will be in place on Canada Street and East Street to allow for a large crane that will be working on the noise enclosure (shown in the green box below).

Under this diversion, access to Canada Street from East Street (downhill) will not be possible. Access from Canada Street to East Street will be unaffected.

If these dates change we will alert you with another notification.



How will this affect me?

Access to all buildings and vehicle crossings will be maintained, however the installation of temporary traffic control will create some small delays. A small amount of on-street parking will be removed on Canada Street and South Street.
